# Carson Country USBC Senior Championships Tournament

## Tournament Rules

1. Entrants may be male or female.
2. All current USBC members aged 50 or over as of January 20, 2018 and in good standing are eligible. Members not sanctioned with CCUSBC may enter by paying the appropriate (state and/or local) membership dues.
3. Entry fee is \$40.00 - Lineage of \$13.50, expenses of \$2.50 and prize fund of \$24.00. Pre-registration for this tournament ends on January 18, 2017. Walk-in bowlers will be allowed to enter one hour prior to the start of the tournament and are subject to \$5.00 late-entry fee.
4. All bowlers will two separate three-game blocks of singles, for a total of six games.
5. Entering averages for handicapping will be determined and in the following order, using averages from bowl.com:
  - a. Highest winter 2016-17 book average;
  - b. Highest summer 2017 book average;
  - c. Highest 2015-16 book average;
  - d. Entrants with no average will enter at 240.
6. It is the responsibility of each entrant to verify the accuracy of age and average. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
7. Handicap will be determined on a series basis, based on 90% of 720.
8. Champions for each division will be determined based on the total pins of all six games plus handicap for each set. There are three divisions for men and three divisions for women. The divisions are:
  - a. Ages 50 – 59;
  - b. Ages 60 – 69;
  - c. Ages 70 and older.
9. A paid entry into the Nevada State Senior Championship will be awarded to the winner of each state open division. Winners must notify the Association Manager to receive a check for the entry fee before registering for the State Tournament. If the CCUSBC Champion in any division is unable to bowl or declines to attend the state event no free entry will be awarded in that division. The divisions for men and women are:
  - a. Super Seniors (75 and older);
  - b. Division A (70 – 74);
  - c. Division B (65 – 69);
  - d. Division C (60 – 64);
  - e. Division D (50 – 59).

10. Entrants are required to check in no less than 30 minutes prior to squad time for lane assignments, presentation of USBC card and age (driver's license, I.D. card, etc.) and average verification. Any participant arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score will count beginning in the frame then being bowled. No score will be given for the frames missed. **Walk-ins must arrive 60 minutes prior to squad time.**
11. In the event of ties for **cash prizes**, money for the places tied will be divided equally. In the event of **first place ties for the paid entry into the State Championship**, all tied bowlers will be receive paid entries.
12. All prize money will be returned 100% on a ratio of 1 in 4 bowlers, or major portion thereof. Prize checks will be distributed within 30 days after the tournament closes (except when USBC has authorized delay in payment pending the settlement of any claim or protest that affects position standings).
13. A maximum of two (2) entries per bowler will be allowed.
14. Substitutes will not be permitted.
15. Disputes involving pin fall, fouls, etc. must be referred to the tournament officials in the frame in question.
16. The tournament officials are empowered to **remove a player(s)** for an infraction of USBC and/or CCUSBC rules and regulations that apply to this tournament.
17. Should a squad have 8 bowlers or less, the Tournament Manager reserves the right to not hold that squad. Bowlers will be advised and asked to **pick** another squad, if available.
18. Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager before the tournament prize payments are made. Recaps are official records of scores bowled.
19. Bowlers using loud or abusive language or conduct unbecoming of a bowler shall have one warning. If misconduct continues, bowler will be removed from the lanes. The bowler will forfeit any awards and prize money to that event.
20. Reasonable attire is required and determination is at the discretion of the Tournament Management.
21. All USBC Rules not mentioned will apply. Tournament Management shall decide any questions not covered by the rules. **The decision of Tournament Management will be final unless appealed in accordance to USBC Rule 329.**
